- reduce Scope 1 & 2 emissions by 51.6% by 2030
- reduce our total Scope 3 emissions by 42% by 2030
- reduce our total Scope 1, 2 and 3 emissions by90% by 2040
- to achieve Net Zero carbon by 2040
- reuse, recycle or compost at least 85% of our waste by 2025 and we will continue to divert 100% of our waste from landfill
- work with our colleagues and suppliers to repair and refurbish our products extending their life to reduce their environmental impact
- become a Nature Positive business helping to halt and reduce biodiversity loss for the benefit of people and the planet by 2030
- reduce carbon emissions and improve local air quality from the products we hire by replacing petrol and diesel products with eco alternatives such as solar, battery, hydrogen and sustainable fuels
- By 2027 70% of our itemised products will be eco technologies
- From 2023 we will install automatic water meter readers and water efficient technologies
